POSITION SUMMARY

Reporting directly to the Campus Pastor of Family Ministries, the KidsLIFE Director will be responsible for casting vision, leading, and overseeing the spiritual development of young children. This role requires a committed leader who is able to preach the gospel, pastor children, engage families, and build and lead a volunteer team. As part of a growing and thriving ministry, the KidsLIFE Director will play a key role in discipling children, supporting their families, and leading children into deeper relationships with Christ.

RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Visionary Leadership & Strategic Planning

- Collaborate with the Campus Pastor of Family Ministries to develop and implement a compelling vision for children's ministry that aligns with the overall mission and vision of LIFEGATE Church.
- Develop and execute both long-term and short-term ministry strategies designed to spiritually grow and disciple children in birth to fifth grade.
- Lead the ministry through regular evaluations of effectiveness, adjusting strategies as needed to ensure growth, engagement, and impact.

2. Preaching & Teaching

- Develop and communicate Bible-based, age-appropriate messages that resonate with the unique needs of children birth to fifth grade.
- Lead and oversee weekly Sunday children's ministry, creating environments where children can encounter God and grow in their faith.

3. Pastoral Care & Discipleship

- Provide pastoral care and discipleship to children, walking alongside them as they with a biblical perspective.
- Establish and maintain meaningful relationships with children through group activities, and consistent interaction.
